ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This case came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on November 16, 2000, and February 22, 2001, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiners Mark Ashley and David R. Catanach, respectively.

NOW, on this 22 day of February, 2001, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner,

FINDS THAT:


- (1) Due public notice has been given and the Division has jurisdiction of this case and its subject matter.
- (2) The applicant, Maynard Oil Company, seeks authorization to simultaneously dedicate a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit comprising the W/2 of Section 13, Township 21 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, to its existing Wilson Deep Unit Well No. 1 located 2080 feet from the North and West lines (Unit F), and to its proposed Wilson Unit Well No. 2 to be located 660 feet from the North and West lines (Unit D) of Section 13.
- (3) This case was originally heard on November 16, 2000, and was taken under advisement at that time.
- (4) Prior to the issuance of an order, this case was reopened to correct an apparent deficiency in notice.

- (5) Prior to the February 22nd hearing, Maynard Oil Company requested that this case be dismissed.
 - (6) The applicant's request should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) The application of Maynard Oil Company for authorization to simultaneously dedicate a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit comprising the W/2 of Section 13, Township 21 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, to its existing Wilson Deep Unit Well No. 1 located 2080 feet from the North and West lines (Unit F), and to its proposed Wilson Unit Well No. 2 to be located 660 feet from the North and West lines (Unit D) of Section 13, is hereby dismissed.
