APPLICATION OF NEWMONT OIL COMPANY FOR TWO UNORTHODOX OIL WELL LOCATIONS AND FOR ONE UNORTHODOX WATER INJECTION WELL LOCATION, LOCO HILLS WATERFLOOD PROJECT, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on February 23, 1961, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Elvis A. Utz, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this <u>3rd</u> day of March, 1961, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Elvis A. Utz, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That by Order No. R-1267, the applicant was authorized to institute a pilot waterflood project in the Loco Hills Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(3) That the applicant seeks permission to expand said waterflood project by adding two producing wells and one water injection well, which are to be located respectively on the following unorthodox locations:

Yates A No. 14 Well, 1980 feet from the North line and 1310 feet from the East line of Section 6, Township 18 South, Range 30 East,

Brigham No. 5 Well, 1320 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line of Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, -2-CASE No. 2193 Order No. R-1267-A

> Brigham No. 4 Well, 1320 feet from the South line and 5 feet from the East line of Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 30 East,

all in Eddy County, New Mexico.

(4) That the proposed unorthodox locations will result in a thorough and efficient sweep of the oil and will not impair correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant be and the same is hereby granted approval for the following-described unorthodox locations for two producing wells and one water injection well in its Loco Hills Waterflood Project, Eddy County, New Mexico:

Yates A No. 14 Well, located 1980 feet from the North line and 1310 feet from the East line of Section 6, Township 18 South, Range 30 East,

Brigham No. 5 Well, located 1320 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line of Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 30 East,

Brigham No. 4 Well, located 1320 feet from the South line and 5 feet from the East line of Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 30 East.

(2) That each of said wells should be cased and cemented in such a manner as to adequately protect all surface waters.

(3) That the injection well shall be cemented in such a manner as to insure that it will withstand injection pressures.
