ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on June 14, 1962, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 17th day of July, 1962, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That by Order No. R-1410-C, entered in Case No. 1641 on September 16, 1960, Special Rules and Regulations were promulgated for the Angels Peak-Gallup Oil Pool.

(3) That the evidence presented at the hearing of this case establishes that the gas area in the Angels Peak-Gallup Oil Pool can be efficiently and economically drained and developed on 320-acre proration units and that the oil area in the pool can be efficiently and economically drained and developed on 80-acre proration units.

(4) That the temporary Special Rules and Regulations promulgated for the subject pool by Order No. R-1410-C should be made permanent.


