## BEFORE THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO

IN THE MATTER OF THE HEARING CALLED BY THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING:

THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING, ABOLISHING, AND EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN CHAVES, EDDY, AND LEA COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

#### ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

### BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on May 18, 1960, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 20th day of May, 1960, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

## FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Devonian formation, said pool to bear the designation West Gladiola-Devonian Pool. Said West Gladiola-Devonian Pool was discovered by H. S. Moss, D. P. Peck Well No. 3, located in the SW/4 of Section 26, Township 12 South, Range 37 East, NMPM. It was completed February 23, 1960. The top of perforations is at 12,208 feet.
- (3) That there is need for the abolishment of the Buffalo Valley-San Andres in Chaves County, New Mexico, as it was created in error.
- (4) That there is need for certain extensions to the Coyote-Queen Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, to the Brushy Draw-Delaware Pool, the Empire-Abo Pool, the West Henshaw-

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Grayburg Pool, the Logan Draw Pool, and the Shugart Pool, all in Eddy County, New Mexico, and to the El Mar-Delaware Pool, the West Pearl-Queen Pool, and the West Teas-Yates Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Devonian production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the West Gladiola-Devonian Pool, consisting of the following described area:

## TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM Section 26: SW/4

(b) That the Buffalo Valley-San Andres Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, and consisting of the following described area:

# TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, NMPM Section 35: SW/4

be and the same, is hereby abolished.

(c) That the Brushy Draw-Delaware Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

## TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 29 EAST, NMPM Section 24: NW/4

(d) That the Coyote-Queen Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

# TOWNSHIP 11 SOUTH, RANGE 27 EAST, NMPM Section 11: N/2 and SE/4 Section 27: W/2

(e) That the El Mar-Delaware Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

# TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM Section 31: NW/4 Partial Section

(f) That the Empire-Abo Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 27 EAST, NMPM Section 35: SE/4

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TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 28 EAST, NMPM Section 33: NW/4 and SE/4

Section 34: S/2

TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 27 EAST, NMPM Section 4: NE/4 and SW/4

Section 16: N/2

(g) That the West Henshaw-Grayburg Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 30 EAST, NMPM Section 10: NE/4

(h) That the Logan Draw Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 27 EAST, NMPM Section 19: SW/4 NE/4

(i) That the West Pearl-Queen Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

> TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPM Section 36: NW/4

That the Shugart Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, NMPM Section 33: S/2 SE/4

TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, NMPM Section 3: SE/4

That the West Teas-Yates Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, (k) as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

> TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM Section 16: W/2 NW/4

### IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the effective date of this order and all creations, abolishments, and extensions included herein shall be June 1, 1960. -4-CASE No. 1968 Order No. R-1681
