ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. July 15, 1952, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 24th day of July, 1952, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony adduced and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That a new pool should be created, classified as an oil pool, and designated as the Corbin-Yates Pool, described as:

Township 18 South, Range 33 East, NMPM LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO E/2 Section 9; W/2 Section 10

(3) That a new pool should be created, classified as an oil pool, and designated as the North Echol-Devonian Pool, described as:

Township 10 South, Range 37 East, NMPM LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO All of Section 21

(4) That the boundaries of the Langlie-Mattix Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, be, and the same hereby are extended to include:

> Township 23 South, Range 37 East, NMPM W/2 W/2 Section 26

(5) That the boundaries of the Artesia Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, be, and the same hereby are extended to include:

Township 18 South, Range 28 East, NMPM E/2 Section 11
