THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING AND EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN EDDY, LEA, AND ROOSEVELT COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO, AND DEFINING THE VERTICAL LIMITS OF AN OIL POOL IN LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on April 13, 1961, at Hobbs, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 18th day of April, 1961, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- That due public notice having been given as required by (1)law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Abo formation, said pool to bear the designation Allison-Abo Pool. Said Allison-Abo Pool was discovered by Gulf Oil Corporation, Federal Mills Well No. 1, located in the NW/4 of Section 11, Township 9 South, Range 36 East, NMPM. It was completed February 1, 1961. The top of perforations is at 8970 feet.
- That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Pennsylvanian formation, said pool to bear the designation East Allison-Pennsylvanian Pool. Said East Allison-Pennsylvanian Pool was discovered by Great Western Drilling Company, Federal "MM" Well No. 1, located in the NE/4 of Section 8, Township 9 South,

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Range 37 East, NMPM. It was completed February 8, 1961. The top of perforations is at 9671 feet.

- (4) That the proposed creation of a new pool in Section 20, Township 17 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Abo formation be <u>dismissed</u> pending further study.
- (5) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Abo formation, said pool to bear the designation East Vacuum-Abo Pool. Said East Vacuum-Abo Pool was discovered by Amerada Petroleum Corporation, State "VC" Well No. 1, located in the SW/4 of Section 36, Township 17 South, Range 35 East, NMPM. It was completed January 29, 1961. The top of perforations is at 8890 feet.
- (6) That there is need for certain extensions to the Atoka-Grayburg Pool, the Brushy Draw-Delaware Pool, and the Loco Hills-Abo Pool, all in Eddy County, New Mexico, to the Arrowhead Pool, the East E K-Queen Pool, the Southwest Gladiola-Pennsylvanian Pool, the Lazy J-Pennsylvanian Pool, the Leamex-Wolfcamp Pool, the Paduca-Delaware Pool, the Pearl-Queen Pool, the Tubb Gas Pool, and the Vacuum-Abo Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico, and to the Bluitt-Pennsylvanian Pool and the South Prairie-Pennsylvanian Pool, both in Roosevelt County, New Mexico.
- (7) That the proposed definition of the vertical limits of the Justis-Blinebry Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, as advertized, should be <u>dismissed</u>.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Abo production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the Allison-Abo Pool, consisting of the following described area:

(b) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Pennsylvanian production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the East Allison-Pennsylvanian Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM Section 8: NE/4

(c) That the proposed creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Abo production, and

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designated as the South Lovington-Abo Pool, consisting of the following-described area:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM Section 20: NE/4

be and the same is hereby dismissed.

That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Abo production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the East Vacuum-Abo Pool, consisting of the following-described area:

That the Arrowhead Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

That the Atoka-Grayburg Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

That the Bluitt-Pennsylvanian Pool in Roosevelt County, (g) New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, NMPM Section 4: NE/4 Section 5: NE/4

(s) That the proposed definition of the vertical limits of the Justis-Blinebry Pool, as advertized, is hereby <u>dismissed</u>.

That the effective date of this order and of all creations and extensions included herein shall be May 1, 1961.
