THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING AND EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN RIO ARRIBA AND SAN JUAN COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on May 16, 1962, at Hobbs, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this <u>23rd</u> day of May, 1962, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the proposed creation of a new pool in Section 10, Township 23 North, Range 7 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Gallup formation should be dismissed pending further study.

(3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Gallup formation, said pool to bear the designation Mesa-Gallup Oil Pool. Said Mesa-Gallup Oil Pool was discovered by Exploration Drilling Company, Navajo #3, located in the SW/4, Unit N, of Section 24, Township 32 North, Range 18 West, NMPM. It was completed August 15, 1961. Top of perforations is 1110 feet. -2-CASE NO. 2563 Order No. R-2242

(4) That there is need for certain extensions to the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and to the Puerto Chiquito-Gallup Oil Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That the proposed creation of a new pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Gallup production, designated as the Lybrook-Gallup Oil Pool, consisting of the following described area:

That the effective date of this order and all creations, extensions, and abolishments included herein shall be June 1, 1962.
