- "(1) That a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool comprising the N/2 NE/4, SE/4 NE/4, <u>E/2</u> SE/4, SW/4 SE/4, and E/2 SW/4 of Section 12, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, is hereby established and dedicated to the Texaco Inc. Roy Riddel Well No. 1, located 661 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line of said Section 12."
- (2) That the correction set out hereinabove shall be effective nunc pro tunc as of May 1, 1963, the effective date of Order No. R-2477.
