 - (6) That Lot 1 can reasonably be presumed to contain approximately 13 productive acres and that Lot 8 can reasonably be presumed to contain approximately 40 productive acres in the Oil Center-Blinebry Pool.
- (2) That the correction set forth above shall be effective nunc pro tunc as of November 10, 1964.
