IN THE MATTER OF THE HEARING CALLED BY THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING:

THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CONTRACTING VERTICAL LIMITS, ABOLISHING, AND EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN CHAVES, LEA, AND ROOSEVELT COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

#### ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

#### BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on April 14, 1965, at Hobbs, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 21st day of April, 1965, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

### FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the proposed contraction of the vertical limits of the Antelope Ridge-Morrow Pennsylvanian Gas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, should be dismissed pending readvertisement of the proposed vertical limits.
- (3) That there is need for the consolidation of the West Bluitt-San Andres Gas Pool and the Bluitt-San Andres Gas Pool, Roosevelt County, New Mexico, inasmuch as both pools produce

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from the same formation. Said consolidation to be accomplished by the abolishment of the West Bluitt-San Andres Gas Pool and extension of the Bluitt-San Andres Gas Pool.

(4) That there is need for certain extensions to the Tobac - Pennsylvanian Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, the Milnesand-San Andres Pool, in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, the Gladiola-Wolfcamp\_Pool and the Lusk-Strawn Pool, both in Lea County, New Mexico.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (a) That the proposed contraction of the vertical limits of the Antelope Ridge-Morrow Pennsylvanian Gas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, is <a href="https://hexample.com/hexam
- (b) That the West Bluitt-San Andres Gas Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, consisting of the following described area:

## TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM SECTION 8: NE/4

### is hereby abolished.

(c) That the Bluitt-San Andres Gas Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

## TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM SECTION 8: NE/4

(d) That the Gladiola-Wolfcamp Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

# TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM SECTION 7: SE/4

(e) That the Lusk-Strawn Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

# TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NMPM SECTION 17: SW/4

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(f) That the Milnesand-San Andres Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

### TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, NMPM

SECTION 4: NW/4

SECTION 5: N/2 and S/2 SE/4

(g) That the Tobac-Pennsylvanian Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NMPM SECTION 25: NE/4

### TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM

SECTION 16: E/2 SW/4 SECTION 28: W/2 SW/4

SECTION 30: NW/4

### IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the effective date of this order and all abolishments, and extensions included herein shall be May 1, 1965.
