NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

BY THE DIVISION:

It appearing to the Division that Order No. R-3169-B, dated October 4, 1983, does not correctly state the intended order of the Division,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

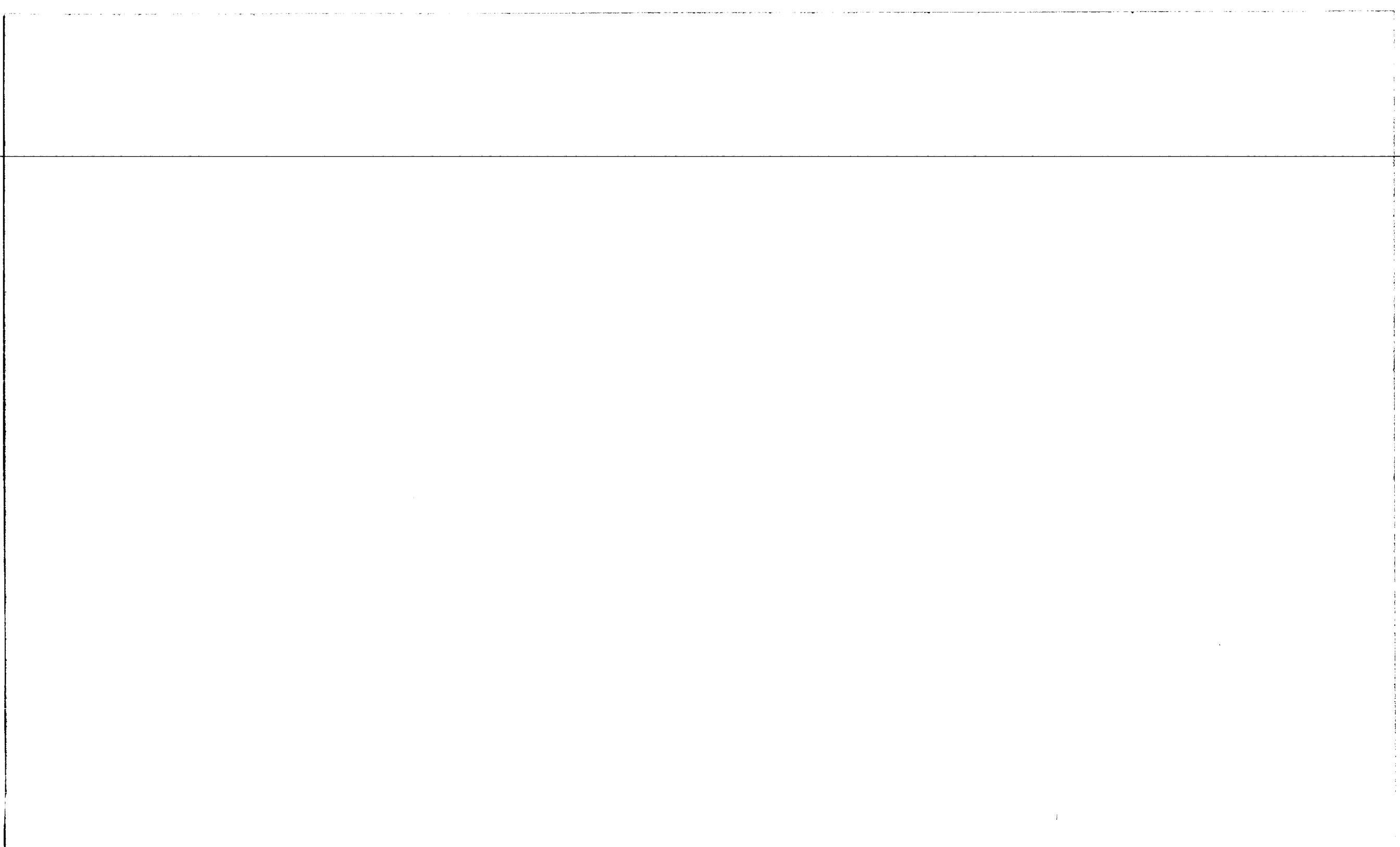
(1) That Finding Paragraph No. (3) on page 1 of Division Order No. R-3169-B, dated October 4, 1983, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(3) That the applicant further seeks the amendment of Division Order Nos. R-3169 and R-3169-A for the Eagle Creek-San Andres Pool, to permit the optional drilling and production of more than one well but not more than five wells on a proration unit therein, such wells being necessary to effectively and efficiently drain the reserves under any affected proration unit."

(2) That Ordering Paragraph No. (2) on pages 2 and 3 of Division Order No. R-3169-B, dated October 4, 1983, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(2) That the authorization for the drilling of more than one well but not more than five wells on proration units within said pool as authorized by Division Order No. R-3169-A is hereby affirmed and any such wells are hereby found to be necessary for the effective and efficient drainage of reserves underlying the proration unit wherein any such well is located within said Eagle Creek-San Andres Pool."

(3) That the corrections set forth in this order be entered nunc pro tunc as of October 4, 1983.




