This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on January 4, 1967, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 9th day of January, 1967, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, United States Smelting Refining and Mining Company, seeks approval of an unorthodox location for its Federal Well No. 2, located 760 feet from the South line and 2080 feet from the West line of Section 11, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the subject well was drilled at the above-described non-standard location inadvertently.
- (4) That approval of the subject application will prevent waste and will not violate correlative rights.

- (2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
