ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on April 5, 1967,
at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 11th day of April, 1967, the Commission, a
quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record,
and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised
in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by
law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject
matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Stoltz & Company, seeks approval of
the unorthodox location in an undesignated Strawn (Pennsylvanian)
gas pool of its Hudson-Federal Well No. 1 at a point 838 feet
from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line of Section
4, Township 21 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New
Mexico, to be dedicated to a non-standard 301.30-acre unit com-
prising Lots 1 through 8 of said Section 4.

(3) That the subject well was drilled as a wildcat oil well
at a standard oil well location to test the Strawn formation.

(4) That the Strawn formation proved to be productive of
gas rather than oil at said location.

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(5) That approval of the subject application will prevent waste and will not violate correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


(1) That an unorthodox location is hereby approved for the Stoltz & Company Hudson-Federal Well No. 1, located 838 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line of Section 4, Township 21 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, undesignated Strawn (Pennsylvanian) gas pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, to be dedicated to a 301.30-acre non-standard unit comprising Lots 1 through 8 of said Section 4.

(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.


