#### ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

#### BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on January 17, 1968, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 22nd day of January, 1968, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

### FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- That there is need for the creation of a new oil pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the San Andres formation, said pool to bear the designation of North Mescalero-San Andres Pool. Said North Mescalero-San Andres Pool was discovered by Cattle Land Oil Company, Atlantic State No. 1, located in Unit G of Section 1, Township 10 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. It was completed in San Andres on September 4, 1967. The top of perforations is 4133 feet.
- (3) That there is need for the re-creation of the East Mason-Delaware Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, inasmuch as the

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East Mason-Delaware Pool and the North Mason-Delaware Pool constitute different common sources of supply.

- (4) That there is need for the deletion of certain acreage from the North Mason-Delaware Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, in order that said acreage may be included in the newly re-created East Mason-Delaware Pool.
- (5) That there is need for the deletion of certain acreage from the Lane-Pennsylvanian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, because said acreage was previously included in the Middle Lane Permo-Pennsylvanian Pool.
- (6) That there is need for certain extensions to the Tomtom San Andres Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, the Baum-Wolfcamp Pool, the South Corbin-Wolfcamp Pool, the Midway-Abo Pool, the North Morton Permo-Pennsylvanian Pool, the Morton-Wolfcamp Pool, and the Vada-Pennsylvanian Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico, and the Todd-Lower San Andres Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico.

### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for San Andres production, is hereby created and designated as the North Mescalero-San Andres Pool, consisting of the following-described area:

(b) That a previously existing pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Delaware production, is hereby re-created and designated as the East Mason-Delaware Pool, consisting of the following-described area:

Section 16: SW/4
Section 17: S/2
Section 20: N/2
Section 21: NW/4

(c) That the North Mason-Delaware Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is

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hereby contracted by the deletion of the following-described area:

#### TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NMPM

Section 16: SW/4 Section 17: S/2 Section 19: NE/4 Section 20: N/2 Section 21: NW/4

(d) That the Lane-Pennsylvanian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby contracted by the deletion of the following-described area:

(e) That the Baum-Wolfcamp Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

# TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM Section 6: NE/4

(f) That the South Corbin-Wolfcamp Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

Section 20: SE/4 Section 21: SW/4

(g) That the Midway-Abo Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

(h) That the North Morton Permo-Pennsylvanian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

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(i) That the Morton-Wolfcamp Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

(j) That the Todd-Lower San Andres Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

(k) That the Tom-tom San Andres Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

# TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, NMPM Section 2: NW/4

(1) That the Vada-Pennsylvanian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

#### TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPM

Section 20: S/2 Section 21: NE/4 Section 27: NW/4 Section 28: N/2

#### IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the effective date of this order and all creations, re-creations, contractions, and extensions included herein shall be February 1, 1968.
