THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER FOR THE CREATION OF NEW POOLS AND THE EXTENSION OF EXISTING POOLS IN SAN JUAN AND RIO ARRIBA COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on July 16, 1953, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 27th, day of July, 1953, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony adduced and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the application of the Oil Conservation Commission upon its own motion for the creation of new pools and the extension of existing pools in San Juan and Rio Arriba Counties, New Mexico, as advertised, should be so ordered.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Dakota production, designated as the Huerfano-Dakota Pool, and described as:

Township 26 North, Range 10 West, NMPM S/2 Section 13; SE/4 Section 14; E/2 Section 23; all Section 24

be, and the same hereby is created.

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(b) That a new pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Dakota production, designated as the Companero-Dakota Pool, and described as:

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Township 27 North, Range 5 West, NMPM W/2 Section 3; all Section 4; N/2 Section 9; NW/4 Section 10

be, and the same hereby is created.

(c) That a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Dakota production, designated as the Blanco-Dakota Pool, and described

Township 31 North, Range 10 West, NMPM
All Section 27; E/2 Section 28;
NE/4 Section 33; N/2 Section 34

be, and the same hereby is created.

(d) That a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Dakota production, designated as the West Kutz-Dakota Pool, and described as:

Township 28 North, Range 12 West, NMPM E/2 Section 21; all Section 22; N/2 Section 27; NE/4 Section 28

be, and the same hereby is created.

(e) That a new pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Dakota production, designated as the South Blanco-Dakota Pool, and described as:

Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM S/2 Section 9; SW/4 Section 10; W/2 Section 15; all Section 16

be, and the same hereby is created.

(f) That the boundary of the classified and defined Fulcher-Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, be extended to include therein as a part of said pool:

Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM W/2 Section 18

(g) That the boundary of the classified and defined West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, be extended to include therein as a part of said pool:

Township 27 North, Range 10 West, NMPM E/2 Section 32

(h) That the boundary of the classified and defined Angels Peak Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, be extended to include therein as a part of said pool:

Township 27 North, Range 10 West, NMPM E/2 Section 9; S/2 and NW/4 Section 10; all Section 15; E/2 Section 16; all Section 22; W/2 Section 23; NW/4 Section 26; N/2 Section 27

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the creations and extensions hereunder be properly entered on the nomenclature plats in the office and field offices of the Commission.
