NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

It appearing to the Commission that due to clerical error, Order No. R-3955, dated May 5, 1970, does not correctly state the intended order of the Commission in one particular,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the location of the Santa Fe Well No. 22 to be drilled in the Tesoro South Hospah Upper Santa Fe Waterflood Project area, as set forth in Order (1), Page 3, of Order No. R-3955, is hereby corrected to read:

"Santa Fe Well No. 22 to be drilled 1200 feet from the North line and 65 feet from the West line of Section 7;"

rather than:

"Santa Fe Well No. 22 to be drilled 1200 feet from the North line and 651 feet from the West line of Section 7;"


(2) That this order shall be effective nunc pro tunc as of May 5, 1970.
