ORDER EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN CHAVES,  
LEA, AND ROOSEVELT COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9:00 a.m. on August 18, 1971, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Elvis A. Utz.

NOW, on this 19th day of August, 1971, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for certain extensions to the Cato-San Andres Pool and the Double L-Queen Associated Pool, both in Chaves County, New Mexico, the North Bagley-Pennsylvanian Pool, the Lusk-Delaware Pool, the West Sawyer-San Andres Pool, and the North Vacuum-Abo Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico, and the Todd-Wolfcamp Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That the North Bagley-Pennsylvanian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 4: SE/4

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(b) That the Cato-San Andres Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 30 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 36: NW/4

(c) That the Double L-Queen Associated Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 30 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 18: NW/4

(d) That the Lusk-Delaware Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 32: NE/4

(e) That the West Sawyer-San Andres Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 22: NW/4

(f) That the Todd-Wolfcamp Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 21: SE/4  
SECTION 22: SW/4, W/2 SE/4, and SE/4 SE/4

(g) That the North Vacuum-Abo Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 12: NE/4  
SECTION 22: SE/4

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 19: NW/4  
SECTION 30: NW/4

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
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:


(1) That, pursuant to Section 65-3-14.5, NMSA 1953, contained in Chapter 271, Laws of 1969, any well which, by virtue of any of the above pool extensions, is subject to pool rules providing for spacing or proration units larger than the one which is presently dedicated thereto, shall have 60 days from the effective date of this order in which to file new Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit for the pool to said well, or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Commission. Pending such compliance, the well shall receive a maximum allowable in the same proportion to a standard allowable for the pool that the acreage dedicated to the well bears to a standard unit for the pool. Failure to file Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit to the well or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Commission within said 60-day period shall subject the well to cancellation of allowable.


(2) That the effective date of this order and all extensions included herein shall be September 1, 1971.
