- "(3) That as to the above-described well, 25% of the commingled production shall be allocated to the Fruitland zone and 75% of the commingled production shall be allocated to the Pictured Cliffs zone."
- (2) That this order shall be effective $\underline{\text{nunc}}$ $\underline{\text{pro}}$ $\underline{\text{tunc}}$ as of July 7, 1972.
