IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Paragraph (3) on Page 3 of Order No. R-4592 shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(3) That after the effective date of this order and within 30 days prior to commencing said well, the operator shall furnish the Commission and each known working interest owner in the subject unit an itemized schedule of estimated well costs."

(2) That the amendment set forth in this order be entered nunc pro tunc as of July 13, 1973.
