- (1) That Paragraph (2) on Page 2 of Order No. R-4705, be and the same is hereby corrected to read as follows:
 - "(2) That the applicant, David Fasken, is hereby authorized to directionally drill the subject well in the manner requested in the application as amended.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that subsequent to the above-described directional drilling, a continuous multishot directional survey shall be made of the wellbore from total depth to the whipstock point with shot points not more than 100 feet apart; that the operator shall cause the surveying company to forward a copy of the survey report directly to the Santa Fe Office of the Commission, Box 2088, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87501, and that the operator shall notify the Commission's Artesia District Office of the date and time said survey is to be commenced."

(2) That this order shall be effective $\underline{\text{nunc}}$ $\underline{\text{pro}}$ $\underline{\text{tunc}}$ as of January 18, 1974.
