(1) That Finding No. (10) on Page 2 of Order No. R-4717-A is hereby corrected to read in its entirety as follows:

"(10) That there are 42 wells, as set out on Exhibit B to this order, which are located within or immediately adjacent to the boundaries of said Skelly Unit Area which may or may not be completed or plugged in such a manner that will assure that they will not serve as channels for injected water to migrate from the Seven Rivers formation to other formations or to the surface."

(2) That this order shall be effective nunc pro tunc as of January 31, 1978.
