ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on February 13, 1974, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this <u>21st</u> day of February, 1974, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Silver Monument Minerals, Inc., seeks approval for an unorthodox oil well location for the San Andres formation for a well to be drilled 1315 feet from the South line and 1315 feet from the West line of Section 25, Township 7 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Chaveroo-San Andres Pool, Roosevelt County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 25 is to be dedicated to the well.
- (4) That said unorthodox location is proposed to determine whether infill drilling in the subject pool may recover oil which would otherwise not be recovered.
- (5) That no offset operator objected to the proposed unorthodox location.
- (6) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the oil in the Chaveroo-San Andres pool and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That an unorthodox oil well location for the San Andres formation is hereby approved for a well to be drilled by applicant at a point 1315 feet from the South line and 1315 feet from the West line of Section 25, Township 7 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Chaveroo-San Andres Pool, Roosevelt County, New Mexico.
- (2) That the SW/4 SW/4 of said Section 25 shall be dedicated to the well.
- (3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
