BY THE COMMISSION:

It appearing to the Commission that due to clerical error and inadvertence, Order No. R-4779, dated May 21, 1974, does not correctly state the intended order of the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Paragraph (1) on Page 2 of Order No. R-4779, be and the same is hereby corrected to read in its entirety as follows:

"(1) That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, is hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the N/2 of Section 17, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, to its Jack B-17 Wells Nos. 3 and 4, located 990 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the East line and 990 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line, respectively, of said Section 17."

(2) That this order shall be effective nunc pro tunc as of May 21, 1974.
