**APPLICATION OF ARCO PERMIAN TO RESCIND DIVISION ORDER NO. R-4808-A AND FOR THE ADOPTION OF SPECIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE RIVERWOLF UNIT (FORMER CITGO EMPIRE-ABO UNIT) INCLUDING SPECIAL OIL ALLOWABLE PROVISIONS, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO**

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on September 15, 1994, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 19th day of September, 1994, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, ARCO Permian, seeks the rescission of Division Order No. R-4808-A, which provided for development of the Riverwolf Unit, formerly the Citgo Empire-Abo Unit, located in portions of Section 35, Township 17 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, and Section 2, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, under statewide rules and regulations and seeks adoption of special allowable limits which will permit production rates at levels consistent with withdrawals from the offsetting Empire-Abo Unit.

(3) Prior to the time of the hearing, the applicant requested this case be dismissed.


(4) The applicant's request for dismissal should be granted.
