ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on December 3, 1975,
at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner R. L. Stamets.

NOW, on this 16th day of December, 1975, the Commission,
a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the
record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully
advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required
by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the
subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Harrington Transportation Inc.,
seeks approval of an unorthodox gas well location for its Higgins
Well No. 1 to be drilled 990 feet from the North line and 990
feet from the East line of Section 13, Township 18 South, Range
26 East, NMPM, to test the Pennsylvanian formation, Atoka-Pennsyl-
vanian Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the E/2 of said Section 13 is to be dedicated to
the well.
- (4) That a well at said unorthodox location will better en-
able applicant to produce the gas underlying the proration unit.
- (5) That no offset operator appeared and objected to the
proposed unorthodox location.
- (6) That approval of the subject application will afford
the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable
share of the gas in the subject pool, will prevent the economic
loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the
augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive
number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect
correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That an unorthodox gas well location for the Pennsylvanian formation is hereby approved for a well to be located at a point 990 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the East line of Section 13, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Atoka-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(2) That the E/2 of said Section 13 shall be dedicated to the above-described well.

(3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
