NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

It appearing to the Commission that Order No. R-5215,  
dated May 18, 1976, does not correctly state the intended  
order of the Commission,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Paragraph (c) of said order is amended to read  
in its entirety as follows:

"(c) That a new pool in Roosevelt County, New  
Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Fusselman  
production, is hereby created and designated as the  
Peterson-Fusselman Pool, consisting of the following  
described area:

TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM  
Section 18: SW/4

Further, that the discovery well for said Peterson-  
Fusselman Pool, being the Amoco Production Company  
Swearingen "C" Well No. 1 located in Unit N of  
Section 18, Township 5 South, Range 33 East, NMPM,  
is hereby assigned a bonus discovery allowable in  
the amount of 39,205 barrels to be produced over  
a two-year period."

(2) That the correction set forth above shall be effective  
nunc pro tunc as of May 18, 1976.
