IN THE MATTER OF DIVISION CASE NO. 5777 BEING REOPENED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF DIVISION ORDER NO. R-5316, WHICH ORDER CREATED AND PROMULGATED TEMPORARY SPECIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE HORSE BACK-PENNSYLVANIAN GAS POOL, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8 a.m. on October 23, 1985, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 5th day of November, 1985, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) By Division Order No. R-5316, dated November 4, 1976, the Division created, defined, and classified the Horse Back-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and Temporary Special Rules and Regulations were promulgated therefor, including a provision for 640-acre gas spacing and proration units based upon an immediate offsetting Pennsylvanian gas pool in Winkler County, Texas.
- (3) Since the inception of the Horse Back-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, there has been no production from the pool.
- (4) At the time of the hearing there were no appearances by interested or affected parties.

- (5) It is not known at this time whether other wells will be completed in the subject pool.
- (6) In the absence of additional testimony showing why the Horse Back-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool should not be abolished, said Division Order No. R-5316 should therefore be rescinded.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) The Horse Back-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM Sections 33 and 34: All

is hereby <u>abolished</u> and Division Order No. R-5316, dated November 4, 1976, is hereby <u>rescinded</u>.

(2) Jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
