NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

It appearing to the Commission that Order No. R-5509, dated August 9, 1977, does not correctly state the intended order of the Commission,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Paragraph (2) on Page 1 of Order No. R-5509, dated August 9, 1977, is hereby corrected to read in its entirety as follows:

"(2) That the applicant, Aztec Oil & Gas Company, seeks approval of an unorthodox gas well location for its Arizona Jicarilla B Well No. 8 at least 790 feet from the North line and at least 790 feet from the West line, but no closer than 130 feet to any quarter-quarter section line, of Section 9, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Blanco Mesaverde Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico."

(2) That Paragraph (1) on Page 2 of Order No. R-5509, dated August 9, 1977, is hereby corrected to read in its entirety as follows:

"(1) That an unorthodox gas well location for the Mesaverde formation is hereby approved for the Aztec Oil & Gas Company Arizona Jicarilla B Well No. 8 to be located at a point at least 790 feet from the North line and at least 790 feet from the West line, but no nearer than 130 feet to any quarter-quarter section line, of Section 9, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Blanco Mesaverde Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico."


(3) That this order shall be effective nunc pro tunc as of August 9, 1977.
