This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on September 14, 1977, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this $15 \, \mathrm{th}$ day of November, 1977, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicants, William G. Rabe and Alice P. Rabe, seek approval of a 160-acre Blanco-Mesaverde non-standard gas proration unit comprising the NE/4 of Section 25, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, to be dedicated to a well to be drilled thereon.
- (3) That the applicants failed to prove the necessity for or propriety of the proposed non-standard proration unit.
 - (4) That the application should be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That the application of William G. Rabe and Alice P. Rabe for a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool comprising the NE/4 of Section 25, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, is hereby denied.
- (2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
