# ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

#### BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on March 7, 1979, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 26th day of February, 1986, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

### FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, Texas Oil & Gas Corporation, seeks approval of an unorthodox location in the Wolfcamp and Pennsylvanian formations for its State Com Well No. 1, to be located 660 feet from the South and West lines of Section 18, Township 21 South, Range 26 East, Catclaw Draw Field, Eddy County, New Mexico, all of said Section 18 to be dedicated to the well in the Morrow formation.
- (3) This matter was scheduled for hearing on March 7, 1979, and was continued indefinitely at that time.
- (4) An excessive amount of time having elapsed with no subsequent request for setting a hearing date, this matter should be dismissed.

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# IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- (1) Commission Case No. 6398 De Novo is hereby dismissed.
- (2) Jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
