order of the Division,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That paragraph (k) on page 4 of Order No. R-6056,  
dated July 19, 1979, is hereby corrected to read in its  
entirety as follows:

"(k) That the Franciscan Lake-Mesaverde Oil Pool  
in McKinley County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified,  
defined, and described, is hereby extended to include  
therein:

TOWNSHIP 20 NORTH, RANGE 5 WEST, NMPM  
Section 18: NW/4 SW/4"

(2) That paragraph (q) on page 6 of Order No. R-6506,  
dated July 19, 1979, is hereby corrected to read in its  
entirety as follows:

"(q) That the South Los Pinos Fruitland-Pictured  
Cliffs Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as hereto-  
fore classified, defined, and described, is hereby  
extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 7 WEST, NMPM  
Section 3: N/2 (Partial)  
Section 4: All

TOWNSHIP 32 NORTH, RANGE 7 WEST, NMPM  
Section 33: S/2"


