NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

BY THE DIVISION:

It appearing to the Division that Order No. R-6293-B dated April 7, 1981, does not correctly state the intended order of the Division,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Order No. 1 of Division Order No. R-6293-B is hereby corrected to read in its entirety as follows:

"(1) That effective April 1, 1981, Rule 4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the West Double X-Wolfcamp Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-6293, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

'RULE 4. A gas well on a standard unit in the West Double X-Wolfcamp Gas Pool shall be permitted to produce no more than 500 MCF of gas per day at standard surface conditions. This shall be known as the daily allowable.'"

(2) That this order shall be effective <u>nunc pro tunc</u> as of April 7, 1981.
