THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING, REDESIGNATING AN EXISTING POOL, AND EXTENDING VERTICAL AND HORIZONTAL LIMITS OF CERTAIN EXISTING POOLS IN CHAVES, EDDY, LEA, AND ROOSEVELT COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on July 2, 1981, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this <u>16th</u> day of July, 1981, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Morrow formation, said pool to bear the designation of East Lusk-Morrow Gas Pool. Said East Lusk-Morrow Gas Pool was discovered by the Grace Petroleum Corporation West Tonto Federal Com Well No. 1 located in Unit L of Section 24, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Morrow formation on January 5, 1981. The top of the perforations is at 13,502 feet.

(3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Mississippian formation, said pool to bear the designation of Peterson-Mississippian Pool. Said Peterson-Mississippian Pool -2-Case No. 7301 Order No. R-6724

was discovered by the Enserch Exploration, Inc. Finley Well No. 1 located in Unit A of Section 6, Township 5 South, Range 33 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Mississippian formation on February 3, 1981. The top of the perforations is at 8,250 feet.

(4) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Wolfcamp formation, said pool to bear the designation of Salado Draw-Wolfcamp Gas Pool was discovered by the Amoco Production Company State GR Well No. 1 located in Unit G of Section 17, Township 26 South, Range 33 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Wolfcamp formation on December 1, 1980. The top of the perforations is at 13,872 feet.

(5) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Strawn formation, said pool to bear the designation of Talco-Strawn Gas Pool. Said Talco-Strawn Gas Pool was discovered by the American Trading and Producing Corporation Talco Unit Well No. 1 located in Unit H of Section 11, Township 26 South, Range 35 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Strawn formation on March 2, 1981. The top of the perforations is at 13,899 feet.

(6) That there is need for the redesignation of the Lusk-Seven Rivers Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, to the North Lusk-Seven Rivers Pool.

(7) That there is need for the extension of the vertical limits of the Lusk-Yates Pool in Eddy and Lea Counties, New Mexico, to include the Seven Rivers formation and the redesignation of said pool to the Lusk Yates-Seven Rivers Pool.

(8) That there is need for certain extensions to the Bull's Eye-San Andres Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, the Angell Ranch Atoka-Morrow Gas Pool, the Atoka-Yeso Pool, the Boyd-Morrow Gas Pool, the South Culebra Bluff-Bone Spring Pool, the Dublin Ranch-Atoka Gas Pool, the East Eagle Creek Atoka-Morrow Gas Pool, the Grayburg Jackson Seven Rivers-Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pool, the North Illinois Camp-Morrow Gas Pool, the North Loving-Morrow Gas Pool, the East Red Lake Queen-Grayburg Pool, and the Richard Knob Atoka-Morrow Gas Pool, all in Eddy County, New Mexico, the Antelope Ridge-Atoka Gas Pool, the Southwest Eunice-San Andres Pool, the Gem-Morrow Gas Pool, the Gladiola-Wolfcamp Pool, the Langlie Mattix Seven Rivers-Queen-Grayburg Pool, the West Nadine-Blinebry Pool, the West Sawyer-San Andres Pool, the Scharb-Wolfcamp Pool, and the Wantz-Abo Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico, and the Tomahawk-San Andres Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico. -3-Case No. 7301 Order No. R-6724

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Morrow production is hereby created and designated as the East Lusk-Morrow Gas Pool, consisting of the following described area:

(b) That a new pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Mississippian production is hereby created and designated as the Peterson-Mississippian Pool, consisting of the following described area:

(c) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Wolfcamp production is hereby created and designated as the Salado Draw-Wolfcamp Gas Pool, consisting of the following described area:

(d) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Strawn production is hereby created and designated as the Talco-Strawn Gas Pool, consisting of the following described area:

(e) That the Lusk-Seven Rivers Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, is hereby redesignated as the North Lusk-Seven Rivers Pool, consisting of the following described area:

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(f) That the vertical limits of the Lusk-Yates Pool in Eddy and Lea Counties, New Mexico, is hereby extended to include the Seven Rivers formation and said pool is redesignated as the Lusk Yates-Seven Rivers Pool, consisting of the following described area:

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

(1) That pursuant to Section 70-2-18, NMSA 1978, contained in Chapter 271, Laws of 1969, any well which by virtue of any of the above pool extensions, is subject to pool rules providing for spacing or proration units larger than the one which is presently dedicated thereto, shall have 60 days from the effective date of this order in which to file new Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit for the pool to said well, or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division. Pending such compliance, the well shall receive a maximum allowable in the same proportion to a standard allowable for the pool that the acreage dedicated to the well bears to a standard unit for the pool. Failure to file Form C-102 dedicating a standard unit to the well or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division within said 60-day period shall subject the well to cancellation of allowable.

(2) That the effective date of this order and all creations, redesignations, and extensions included herein shall be August 1, 1981.
