ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on March 16, 1982, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this 9th day of April, 1982, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Viking Petroleum, Inc., seeks approval of an unorthodox location of a well located in Unit H of Section 31, Township 13 South, Range 34 East, Nonombre-Pennsylvanian Pool, said well being a recompleted Morrow test.

(3) That while the well was a recompleted Morrow test in the SE/4 of the quarter section, the pool rules require wells to be located in the NE/4 or SW/4 of the quarter section.

(4) That a well at said unorthodox location will better enable applicant to produce the hydrocarbons underlying the proration unit.

(5) That no offset operator objected to the proposed unorthodox location.

(6) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable

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share of the hydrocarbons in the subject pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Viking Petroleum, Inc. is hereby authorized an unorthodox well location for its Dome No Nombre 31 State Well located in Unit H of Section 31, Township 13 South, Range 34 East, Nonombre-Pennsylvanian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

(2) That the NE/4 of said Section 31 shall be dedicated to the above-described well.

(3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
