ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m., on September 15, 1955, and a portion thereof continued until and heard on October 13, 1955, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW on this 29th day of December, 1955, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

1. That due notice of the time and place of hearing and the purpose thereof having been given as prescribed by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

2. That a portion of subject matter of Section (c) of the application pertaining to the extension of the Ballard Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, has now been incorporated into Order R-672-B, resulting from the hearing in Case 908, and, therefore, requires no further action herein; said subject acreage in San Juan County, New Mexico, is described as follows:

TOWNSHIP 26 NORTH, RANGE 9 WEST

Section 2: All

Section 3: N/2

Section 4: SE/4

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That a portion of Section (c) of the application in Case 955 covering the following described properties: All of Section 2, N/2 Section 3, SE/4 of Section 4, Township 26 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, be and the same is hereby dismissed.
