IN THE MATTER OF THE HEARING CALLED BY THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION ON ITS OWN MOTION TO PERMIT FLAG-REDFERN OIL CO., PRINCIPAL, NATIONAL SURETY CORPORATION, AND ALL OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES TO APPEAR AND SHOW CAUSE WHY FOUR WELLS, BEING THE JULANDER NO. 1 LOCATED IN UNIT L, SECTION 34, JULANDER NO. 2 LOCATED IN UNIT I, SECTION 33: HARGIS NO. 1 IN UNIT G, SECTION 33; AND HARGIS NO. 2 LOCATED IN UNIT J, SECTION 33, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 30 NORTH, RANGE 12 WEST, SAN JUAN COUNTY, SHOULD NOT BE PLUGGED AND ABANDONED IN ACCORDANCE WITH A DIVISION-APPROVED PLUGGING PROGRAM.
