CERTAIN POOLS IN CHAVES, EDDY, LEA,
AND ROOSEVELT COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

BY THE DIVISION:

It appearing to the Division that Order No. R-7048, dated August 9, 1982, does not correctly state the intended order of the Division,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Finding No. (9) on page 3 of Order No. R-7048 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(9) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Abo formation, said pool to bear the designation of Northwest Townsend-Abo Pool. Said Northwest Townsend-Abo Pool was discovered by the Charles B. Gillespie, Jr. Exxon Townsend Well No. 1 located in Unit B of Section 9, Township 16 South, Range 35 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Abo formation on September 25, 1981. The top of the perforations is at 8,716 feet."

(2) That paragraph no. (h) on page 5 of Order No. R-7048 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(h) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Abo production is hereby created and designated as the Northwest Townsend-Abo Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, NMPM
Section 9: NE/4"


(3) That the corrections set forth in this order be entered nunc pro tunc as of August 9, 1982.
