THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION  
DIVISION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER  
CREATING, ASSIGNING DISCOVERY ALLOWABLES,  
CONTRACTING, AND EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS  
IN CHAVES, EDDY, LEA, AND ROOSEVELT  
COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

BY THE DIVISION:

It appearing to the Division that Order No. R-7114, dated  
October 19, 1982, does not correctly state the intended order  
of the Division,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Finding No. (2) on page 1 of Order No. R-7114 be  
and the same is hereby corrected to read in its entirety as  
follows:

"(1) That there is need for the creation of a new  
pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil  
from the Cherry Canyon formation, said pool to bear the  
designation of Antelope Ridge-Cherry Canyon Pool. Further,  
that there is need for the assignment of a discovery allow-  
able of 33,670 barrels to the discovery well, the Estoril  
Production Corporation Triple A Federal Well No. 2 located  
in Unit J of Section 10, Township 23 South, Range 34 East,  
NMPM. It was completed in the Cherry Canyon formation on  
May 30, 1982. The top of the perforations is at 6,734  
feet."

(2) That paragraph (a) on page 3 of Order No. R-7114 be  
and the same is hereby corrected to read in its entirety as  
follows:

"(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico,  
classified as an oil pool for Cherry Canyon production  
is hereby created and designated as the Antelope Ridge-  
Cherry Canyon Pool, consisting of the following described  
area:

TOWNSHIP 23 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPM  
Section 10: SE/4

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
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Further, that the discovery well for said Antelope Ridge-Cherry Canyon Pool, being the Estoril Production Corporation Triple A Federal Well No. 2 located in Unit J of Section 10, Township 23 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, is hereby assigned a bonus discovery allowable in the amount of 33,670 barrels to be produced over a two-year period."

(3) That the corrections set forth in this order be entered nunc pro tunc as of October 19, 1982.
