This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on November 16, 1955, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this $9^{\frac{t}{h}}$ day of December 1955, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- 1. That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- 2. That there is need for certain extensions in the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, both in San Juan County, New Mexico, and the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool in San Juan and Rio Arriba Counties, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, be and the same hereby is extended to include therein:

(b) That the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool in San Juan and Rio Arriba Counties, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, be and the same hereby is extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 27 NORTH, RANGE 11 WEST, NMPM Section 4: NW/4
