BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on April 13, 1983, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this <u>25th</u> day of April, 1983, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Amoco Production Company, seeks approval of an unorthodox gas well location 660 feet from the North line and 710 feet from the West line of Section 15, Township 19 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Scharb-Bone Springs Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

(3) That the N/2 NW/4 of said Section 15 is to be dedicated to the well.

(4) That by Division Order No. R-2589-C entered April 13, 1983, the Special Rules and Regulations for the Scharb-Bone Springs Pool were amended in such a manner as to render the proposed location standard.

(5) That there being no further need for approval of the subject application, it should be <u>dismissed</u>.

(1) That the application of Amoco Production Company for an unorthodox gas well location for a well to be located at a point 660 feet from the North line and 710 feet from the West line of Section 15, Township 19 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Scharb-Bone Springs Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, is hereby <u>dismissed</u>.

(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
