(2) That the subject matter of the application herein is now fully covered by Order R-111-A and that no further action is deemed necessary on subject application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of the Duval Sulphur and Potash Company for extension of Area "A" of the potash - oil area in Eddy County, as presently defined by Order R-111 issued in Case 278, be and the same is hereby dismissed.
