APPLICATION OF INEXCO OIL COMPANY
FOR COMPULSORY POOLING, AN UNORTHODOX
LOCATION, AND A NON-STANDARD PRORATION
UNIT, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

BY THE DIVISION:

It appearing to the Division that Order No. R-7359, dated September 26, 1983, does not correctly state the intended order of the Division;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Order No. (2) on page 3 of Order No. R-7359 be and the same is hereby corrected to read in its entirety as follows:

"(2) That all mineral interests, whatever they may be, in the South Humble City-Strawn Pool underlying the SE/4 SW/4 and the SW/4 SE/4 of said Section 13, are hereby pooled to form an 80-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit to be dedicated to the applicant's said Norris Well No. 2.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the operator of said units shall commence the drilling of said well on or before the 1st day of December, 1983, and shall thereafter continue the drilling of said well with due diligence to a depth sufficient to test all formations overlying the Mississippian formation;

PROVIDED FURTHER, that in the event said operator does not commence the drilling of said well on or before the 1st day of December, 1983, Order (1) of this order shall be null and void and of no effect whatsoever, unless said operator obtains a time extension from the Division for good cause shown.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that should said well not be drilled to completion, or abandonment, within 120 days after commencement thereof, said operator shall appear before the Division Director and show cause why Order (1) of this order should not be rescinded."

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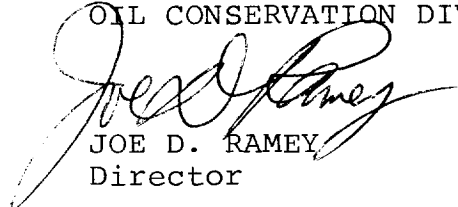
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(2) That the corrections set forth in this order be entered nunc pro tunc as of September 26, 1983.
