ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m., on January 19, 1956, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 20th day of February, 1956, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

1. That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
2. That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Pennsylvanian formation, said pool to bear the designation SRR-Pennsylvanian Pool. Said SRR-Pennsylvanian Pool was discovered by Amerada Petroleum Corporation, Federal "E" No. 1, located in NE/4 NE/4 Section 22, Township 9 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. It was completed October 10, 1955. The top of the perforations is at 9208'.
3. That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Devonian formation, said pool to bear the designation South Denton-Devonian Pool. Said South Denton-Devonian Pool was discovered by Signal Oil and Gas Company, Gulf-State #1, located in Lot 4, Section 4, Township 16 South, Range 38 East, NMPM. It was completed November 23, 1955. The top of the perforations is at 13,110'.
4. That there is need for certain extensions to the Hardy Pool, the Langlie-Mattix Pool, the Skaggs Pool, the Terry-Blinbry Oil Pool and the Townsend-Wolfcamp Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Pennsylvanian production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the SRR-Pennsylvanian Pool, consisting of the following described area.

TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NMPM

Section 14: SW/4
Section 15: SE/4
Section 22: NE/4
Section 23: NW/4

(b) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Devonian production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the South Denton-Devonian Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM

Section 35: SE/4
Section 36: SW/4

TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM

Section 4: Lots 3, 4, 5 and 6
Section 5: Lots 1, 2, 7 and 8

(c) That the Hardy Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM

Section 4: Lot 4

(d) That the Langlie-Mattix Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM

Section 12: All

(e) That the Skaggs Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM

Section 5: SW/4

(f) That the Terry-Blinebry Oil Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM
Section 33: NE/4


(g) That the Townsend-Wolfcamp Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, NMPM
Section 33: W/2

TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, NMPM
Section 1: W/2
Section 2: Lots 1, 2, 7, 8, 9, 10, 15 and 16
