PROM, WESTERN SURETY COMPANY, AND ALL OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES TO APPEAR AND SHOW CAUSE WHY THE CROWN POINT WELL NO. 1 LOCATED IN UNIT F OF SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 18 NORTH, RANGE 13 WEST, McKINLEY COUNTY, SHOULD NOT BE PLUGGED AND ABANDONED IN ACCORDANCE WITH A DIVISION-APPROVED PLUGGING PROGRAM:

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8 a.m. on February 29, 1984, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 7th day of March, 1984, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That Gerald J. Prom is the owner and operator of the Crown Point Well No. 1, located in 2439 feet from the North line and 2300 feet from the West line of Section 18, Township 18 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, McKinley County, New Mexico.
- (3) That Western Surety Company is the surety on the Oil Conservation Division plugging bond on which Gerald J. Prom is principal.
- (4) That the purpose of said bond is to assure the state that the subject well will be properly plugged and abandoned when not capable of commercial production.
- (5) That in order to prevent waste and protect correlative rights said well should be plugged and abandoned in accordance with a program approved by the Aztec District Office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on or before June 1, 1984, or

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the well should be returned to active drilling status or placed on production.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That Gerald J. Prom and Western Surety Company are hereby ordered to plug and abandon the Crown Point Well No. 1, located in 2439 feet from the North line and 2300 feet from the West line of Section 18, Township 18 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, McKinley County, New Mexico, or in the alternative, to return the well to active drilling status or place the well on production on or before June 1, 1984.
- (2) That Gerald J. Prom and Western Surety Company, prior to plugging and abandoning the above-described well, shall obtain from the Aztec office of the Division, a Division-approved program for said plugging and abandoning, and shall notify said Aztec office of the date and hour said work is to be commenced whereupon the Division may, at its option, witness such work.
- (3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
