COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

BY THE DIVISION:

It appearing to the Division that Order No. R-7682,  
dated September 28, 1984, does not correctly state the  
intended order of the Division,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) Finding Paragraph No. (3) on page 1 of Division  
Order No. R-7682 be and the same is hereby corrected to read  
in its entirety as follows:


"(3) The applicant, Amerind Oil Co., seeks an  
order pooling all mineral interests in the Pennsyl-  
vanian formation underlying the S/2 NW/4 of Section  
28, Township 16 South, Range 37 East, NMPM,  
Northeast Lovington-Pennsylvanian Pool, Lea County,  
New Mexico, to be dedicated to its Speight Well No.  
2 to be drilled at a standard location thereon."

(2) Ordering Paragraph No. (1) on page 3 of Division  
Order No. R-7682 be and the same is hereby corrected to read  
in its entirety as follows:

"(1) All mineral interests, whatever they may  
be, in the Pennsylvanian formation underlying the  
S/2 NW/4 of Section 28, Township 16 South, Range 37  
East, NMPM, Northeast Lovington-Pennsylvanian Pool,  
Lea County, New Mexico, are hereby pooled to form a  
standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit to  
be dedicated to the Speight Well No. 2 to be drilled  
at a standard location thereon."

(3) The corrections set forth in this order be entered  
nunc pro tunc as of September 28, 1984.
