NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

It appearing to the Commission that Order No. R-7817-B,  
dated November 15, 1985, does not correctly state the intended  
order of the Commission,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) Finding Paragraph No. (14) on page 3 of Commission  
Order No. R-7817-B, dated November 15, 1985, issued in Case  
No. 8699, be and the same is hereby amended to read in its  
entirety as follows:

"(14) Based upon Findings Nos. (11) and (12)  
above, the allocation of original tangible and in-  
tangible well costs, exclusive of any costs attribu-  
table and chargeable solely to either individual zone,  
should be as follows:

- (a) owners of interests in the shallow  
interval should pay for 58 percent of  
the costs of drilling to the depth of  
10,000 feet; and
- (b) owners of interests in the deeper  
interval should pay for 42 percent of  
the costs of drilling to the depth of  
10,000 feet and 100 percent of the  
costs for drilling from 10,000 feet to  
total depth."


(2) The corrections set forth in this order be entered
