THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING, CONTRACTING, AND EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN MCKINLEY, RIO ARRIBA, SAN JUAN, AND SANDOVAL COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8 a.m. on August 14, 1985, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this <u>22nd</u> day of August, 1985, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) There is need for the creation of a new pool in McKinley County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Mesaverde formation, said pool to bear the designation of Papers Wash-Mesaverde Oil Pool. Said Papers Wash-Mesaverde Oil Pool was discovered by the James L. Ludwick Federal 8 Well No. 4 located in Unit M of Section 8, Township 19 North, Range 5 West, NMPM. It was completed in the Mesaverde formation on June 21, 1983. The top of the perforations is at 1,945 feet.

(3) There is need for the contraction of the Otero-Gallup Oil Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The deleted acreage will be included in the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool. -2-Case No. 8680 Order No. R-8022

(4) There is need for certain extensions to the BS Mesa-Gallup Pool, the Devils Fork-Gallup Associated Pool, the Devils Fork-Mesaverde Oil Pool, the Gavilan-Mancos Oil Pool, the Ojito Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool, the Tapacito-Gallup Associated Pool, and the Wild Horse-Gallup Pool, all in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and the Bisti-Lower Gallup Oil Pool, the Dufers Point Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool, the South Gallegos Fruitland-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the North Pinon-Fruitland Pool, the Twin Mounds-Mesaverde Pool, and the WAW Fruitland-Pictured Cliffs Pool, all in San Juan County, New Mexico, and the South Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool and the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool, both in Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico, and the Otero-Chacra Pool in San Juan and Rio Arriba Counties, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(a) A new pool in McKinley County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Mesaverde production is hereby created and designated as the Papers Wash-Mesaverde Oil Pool, consisting of the following described area:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

(1) Pursuant to Section 70-2-18, NMSA 1978, contained in Chapter 271, Laws of 1969, any well, which by virtue of any of the above pool extensions, is subject to pool rules providing for spacing or proration units larger than the one which is presently dedicated thereto, shall have 60 days from the effective date of this order in which to file new Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit for the pool to said well, or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division. Pending such compliance the well shall receive a maximum allowable in the same proportion to a standard allowable for the pool that the acreage dedicated to the well bears to a standard unit for the pool. Failure to file Form C-102 dedicating a standard unit to the well or to obtain a nonstandard unit approved by the Division within said 60-day period shall subject the well to cancellation of allowable.

(2) The effective date of this order and all creations, contractions, and extensions included herein shall be September 1, 1985.
