ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on May 16, 1956 at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 8th day of June, 1956, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Devonian formation, said pool to bear the designation North Gladiola-Devonian Pool. Said North Gladiola-Devonian Pool was discovered by Ralph Lowe U. U. Wallace #1, located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 6, Township 12 South, Range 38 East, NMPM. It was completed March 24, 1956. The top of the perforations is at 12,010 feet.

(3) That there is need for certain extensions to the Blinebry Oil Pool, the Terry-Blinebry Pool, and the Townsend-Wolfcamp Pool all in Lea County, New Mexico, the Caprock-Queen Pool in Lea and Chaves Counties, New Mexico and the Grayburg-Keely Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Devonian production be and the same is hereby created and designated as the North Gladiola-Devonian Pool consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM
NE/4 Section 6

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(b) That the Blinebry Oil Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM
All Section 29

(c) That the Caprock-Queen Pool in Lea and Chaves Counties, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NMPM
W/2 W/2 Section 31

TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, NMPM
E/2 NE/4 Section 20

(d) That the Grayburg-Keely Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico as heretofore classified, defined and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 29 EAST, NMPM
NW/4 Section 23

(e) That the Terry-Blinebry Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM
NW/4 Section 34


(f) That the Townsend-Wolfcamp Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPM
N/2 & N/2 S/2 Section 36


TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, NMPM
S/2 S/2 Section 31
