NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

BY THE DIVISION:

It appearing to the Division that Orders Nos. R-8253 and R-8253-A, both effective June 25, 1986, do not correctly state the intended order of the Division,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) Only that portion of Exhibit "A", which is attached to and made a part of Division Order No. R-8253, which order was subsequently corrected by Division Order No. R-8253-A, describing the "City of Farmington Well No. 2" is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:


"City of Farmington Well No. 2:

Surface Location: 2159 feet from the South line and 1712 feet from the East line;
Approximate Kick-Off Point from Vertical: 750 feet; Bottom Hole Location: Within 100 feet of a point 1650 feet from the South and West lines."

(2) The corrections set forth in both orders be entered nunc pro tunc as of June 25, 1986.
