It appearing to the Commission that Order No. R-8353,
dated November 20, 1986, does not correctly state the
intended order of the Commission,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) Finding Paragraph No. (6) on page 2 of Order No.
R-8353 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(6) The proposed amendment and addition will
guarantee to any party being pooled that due process
requirements are met and will not result in waste or
violation of correlative rights and should be adopted
effective March 30, 1987."

(2) Ordering Paragraph No. (3) on page 2 of Order No.
R-8353 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(3) The effective date of this order and the
rule amendment and addition contained herein shall be
March 30, 1987."

(3) The corrections set forth in this order be entered
nunc pro tunc as of November 20, 1986.


